international competition that will be held in Milan on June 13th, 14th, 2009 with the partnership of the National Olympic Committee (CONI), of the Regione Lombardia Regional Government, of the Milan Provincial Administration Sport Councillorship and with the cooperation of the FITARCO Regional and Provincial Committees.

The competition will take place at the **Centro Sportivo** located in **Via P. Neruda** in **Cernusco sul Naviglio (Milan)** with the formula of the **70m Round + Olympic Round** according to the following scheduling:

The Prize giving will include the awarding of the “**ABA Challenge Trophy Silver Collar**” to the best Qualification score (Man or Woman) in the Recurve Bow ranking and in the Compound Bow ranking. The prize will be final property of the archer that wins it for three times, even not in succession. The complete list of the prizes will be detailed more over.

The competition is open to Senior Men and Women Classes for the Recurve Bow and Compound Bow Divisions. **Master, Junior and Cadet archers will be allowed to participate included in the Senior ranking, as of FITA Rules.**

The shooting venue can hold 32 targets, therefore 128 archers will be registered for each Division.

Entry fee: 20 Euro. The entries will start on May 1st, 2009 and can be submitted to the Competition Secretary c/o AGM using the official Fitarco form or by e-mail: segreteria@arcierigrandemilano.org.

The National Teams registered directly by the National Associations and the Club Teams from abroad will have priority of registration and can be registered since the end of January 2009
